On the **Learning objectives** page:

1. select the year required
2. select individual substrands or all of the strands and substrands
3. go to the bottom of the page and select 'Go'

This takes you to the chosen substrands.

Alternatively, to view an individual substrand, select it directly from the links listed on the left hand side of the page.

The box on the left hand side, 'Sections in Modern foreign languages' has a link to **CPD** (continuing professional development – <http://nationalstrategies.standards.dcsf.gov.uk/search/mfl/results/nav:49828>)

Selecting this takes you to a page listing the modules.

To access the modules you have to join the course covering these modules. To do this:

1. select the top link – 'Modern foreign languages (MFL) e-learning modules' (<http://nationalstrategies.standards.dcsf.gov.uk/node/171044>)
2. ensure you are logged-in (if you are not logged-in select 'Log in' at the top right of the page)
3. select **Join** (bottom right of page)

The modules will then be listed, along with a brief description of each, and you can select the one you want.
